Introduction:

The purpose of this document is to provide an overview of the operations provided to enable integration between the AudaNet (AXN) platform and BodyShop Management Systems (BMS). AudaNet is a claim estimating system that generates a repair quote using manufacturing times and methods, integration with this platform will enable the download of the Audatex certified estimate into a BodyShop Management system to allow repairers to efficiently manage the repair job through to completion.

Some underlying principles behind integration with the AudaNet platform:

- The initial quote is always written in AudaNet, then downloaded to the BMS.
- Downloading to the BMS is an optional step for the repairer.
- There are 3 web services provided for this integration (to be detailed in this document)
 - Download Quote
 - Submit Parts
 - Submit Sublets
- No changes can be made to the Audatex times or methods via BMS integration; these must be done in AudaNet.

PNET standard workflow:

Below is a step-by-step walk through of the standard workflow for PNET; this process is to be used for any jobs relating to Suncorp Insurance work where the repairer is a Suncorp Partnered repairer. In this process the claim will always be created by Suncorps Claim Centre (CC) systems via PNET; repairers cannot initiate this process.

1. Claim is lodged and Suncorp invite a repairer to Quote
2. BMS & AXN receive Request For Quote (R4Q) from PNet at same time
 - a. BMS create shell of quote
3. Quote is created/modified in AXN
4. (Optional) Parts & Sublets are modified via BMS:
 - a. BMS downloads quote from AXN
 - b. BMS adds parts / sublets to the quote
 - i. BMS submits parts to Parts Check for pricing or uses other parts data source (Optional)

- ii. BMS receives prices from Parts Check or other parts data source (Optional)
- c. BMS submits parts / sublets back to AXN - 2 Services.
- d. Quote is updated in AXN (repairer must re-calculate)
- 5. AXN submits quote to PNet for authorisation
- 6. AXN & BMS receives authorisation **AUQT (BMS ingests/accepts authorised quote detail entirely)**
- 7. For supplementaries, repairer can repeat steps 2 to 6
- 8. BMS submits invoice to PNET
- 9. AXN will close the case once it has been invoiced.

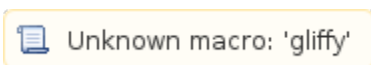
Modifying the Parts & Sublets via BMS

Using a BMS to modify the Parts & Sublets is an optional step in the process, which will provide benefits around updating parts information for large quotes if another parts data source is available and in use. Additionally we recognise that each system could gain added benefits from having this information in the BMS prior to receiving the authorised copy from PNet, such as parts ordering and job scheduling.

The next sections of this document will focus on the 4 services available between the AudaNet platform and any BMS system. Should you require further information around the PNET workflow and the way this operates we recommend you contact Suncorp.

Quote Data Flow:

The below diagram has been created to highlight the way quote information is transferred between the systems using these services:



Download Quote:

This operation is used to download the quote into the BMS system. The parameters are:

- AudaNet Credentials
- Quote request number
- Quote request version number
- Generator identifying the caller of the operation
- Version of the generator
- Delta flag

Download quote is used to download the quote created in AudaNet to the BMS. The BMS can choose between the following options when downloading the quote:

1. Download the whole quote, this option should be used when the BMS is downloading the quote for the first time and no supplementary has been added or when the BMS wants to get the whole quote for a second time and calculate the delta within the BMS.
2. Download Delta, this option should be used after the main quote is authorised and a supplementary has been added.

Download Delta:

To download the delta the <downloadDelta> flag must be set to true. This modifies the downloadquote service to only provide the modified line items.

Details of this function:

- If the main quote is authorised and the first supplementary is added, downloading the delta will return the line items that have been modified or added as part of this supplementary. Once this has been downloaded the user can upload modifications to the parts and sublets similar to the main quote services.
- If the additional supplements are added to the case (2nd and 3rd etc) using the download delta will return to the BMS the line items that have been added or updated in the second supplementary. ie. a comparison between the last authorised estimate and the new supplementary.
- BMS user shouldn't be able to add new or modify the existing External Sublets in the supplementary quote.



BMS will not be able to lock or unlock the case in AudaNet. The behavior will be the same if you set lockQuote field to true or false

Submit Parts:

The submit part service allows repairs to update the meta-data in the AudaNet estimate. This means that repairers can modify this information via the BMS (and any integrated parts data sources) before submitting it back to AudaNet. AudaNet classifies parts into 2 categories which function slightly different as described below:

AudaNet Parts:

AudaNet parts are parts that are attached to a panel and/or paint labour time or repair function in Damage Capture (DC) and as such cannot be changed anywhere but DC in AudaNet. Below are some rules that apply to AudaNet Parts:

1. BMS cannot add new AXN part when using the submit parts service. (This is only be done by using AXN damage capture)
2. BMS can modify the following parameters for AudaNet Parts:
 - a. Following are the part types and its code

Non-Audanet Parts:

Non-AudaNet parts provide a little more flexibility; but they will not impact any other part of the calculation (labour, paint etc) they simply add the part as an additional line item. Details on how they can be used below:

1. BMS can add Non-Audanet parts via the submitparts service
2. Fields that can be modified
 - a. Part type: (Refer to the table: Audanet Parts, 2 a.)
 - b. Part Number - 15 characters MAX
 - c. Part Price - No negative values accepted
 - d. Part Supplier - 30 characters MAX
3. Filed cannot be modified

- a. Quantity - (Always be 1, but it wont reflect anywhere in AudaNet UI as there is no particular field for quantity in AudaNet)
 - b. Parts Description - Allowed character Max 20)
4. Quote line number should be blank while submitting new non-AudaNet parts from BMS (AudaNet will assign new Quote line number for the newly added part from BMS)

 BMS can NOT remove Parts/Sublets using submit parts function. To remove a part the user should go to AudaNet damage capture and remove the part.

 When submitting a part back to AudaNet, please consider the following:

1. No negative value for part price
2. If the part was updated in supplementary and in BMS it is represented in 2 line items (1 for the main quote and another for the difference in the supplementary), you have to combine those 2 lines before submitting this part back to AudaNet.
3. To update an existing part you have to send the quote line number in the request, if you didn't send the Quote line number, AudaNet will consider this part as new part and will assign a new Quote Line number. This will cause duplication of parts in AudaNet with same line items.
4. BMS will not be able to lock or unlock case in AudaNet. The behavior will be the same if you set unlockQuote field to true or false.
5. Audanet won't support Parts Quantity. To maintain the consistency of BMS web service with PNET, we always mention the Parts Quantity as 1. But the quantity is not reflected anywhere in AudaNet UI.
6. 0 is still consider as a value for Quote Line Number. So it should be leave as blank, when submitting new Non AudaNet Part from BMS.

Submit Sublets:

The submit sublets service allows repairs to update and add sublets to the quote. There are 2 types of sublets allowed, these work slightly differently as described below:

Internal Sublets:

Internal Sublets are work that the repairer is managing the payment of internally. The price of these will appear on the estimate that is sent to the insurer for authorisation and also payment. AudaNet will accept the below changes from a BMS for Internal sublets:
