Course Objectives

- Gain or maintain Audatex Certification to demonstrate your ability and level of competency as a Vehicle Damage Estimator or Assessor
- Achieve the necessary level of competency required to create a comprehensive methods-driven estimate.
- Recognise the importance of carrying out safe and appropriate assessments using approved repair methods involving EV technology.
- Understand the latest Qapter/Audanet system enhancements, with the intention of refreshing existing skills and enhancing efficient workflow technique.

Course Format

This online training session combines an Electric Vehicle (EV) Safety Awareness module with a trainer-led EV damage estimation exercise using the Qapter/AudaNet platform. The format includes an engaging mix of slides, videos, live demonstrations, class discussion, and Q&A.

Following the session, delegates will complete a multiple-choice knowledge check and an EV-based damage estimation assessment in their own time. Successful participants will receive a Certificate of Competency. Those requiring further support will receive constructive feedback and the opportunity to attend the 2-day Introduction to AudaNet course*

The online training session will begin at 09.00am and run for approximately 2-3 hours, depending on the level of discussion and questions raised. Delegates must complete the multi-choice questionnaire and damage estimate exercise by no later than 4:00pm on the same day.

Who should attend?

This course is designed for repairers and assessors who use AudaNet/Qapter daily. It will help delegates stay up to date with system rules and functions. Refresh and build upon existing skills to achieve their annual Audatex qualification, a recognised credential valuable for career progression and recruitment vetting.
